## Audubon Center at Riverlands

301 Riverlands Way, West Alton, 63386



Located in the Riverlands Migratory Bird Sanctuary. Begin your journey at the pond named after a blue winged duck, that is typically the first to arrive on migration!

**Trail Level: EASY (grass and gravel, flat)**

## Queeny Park

550 Weidman Rd, St. Louis, MO 63131



Enter the park from S Mason Rd. Explore S on the trail headed towards a playground for 4-legged friends. Bark! Explore around trail to the right & the trees and stream on the way.

**Trail Level: MEDIUM (paved, non-paved, partially inclined)**

## Forest Park

6500 Government Dr, St. Louis, 63110

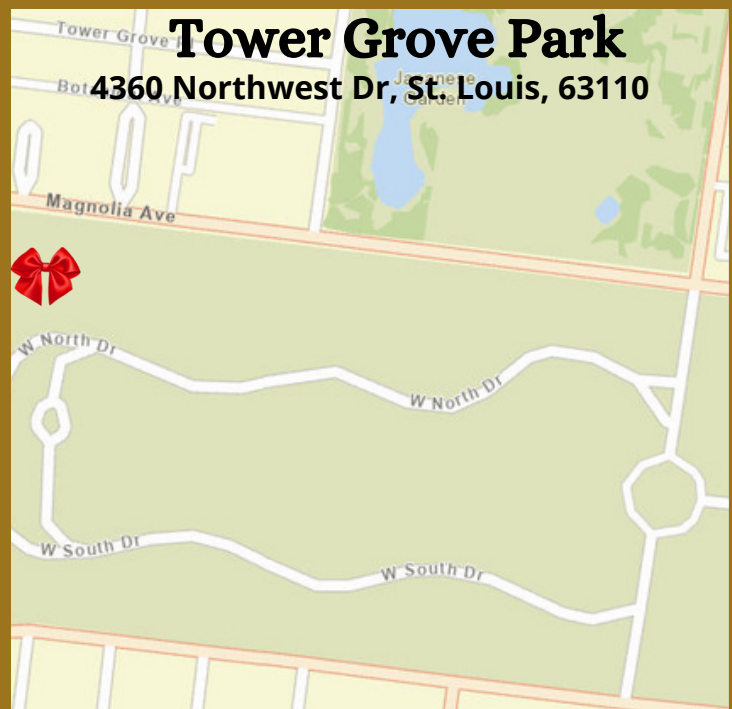


Head to the forest named after our 35th president and begin on the trail just north of the Wells Dr and Government Drive roundabout.

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, moderate incline)**

## Tower Grove Park

4360 Northwest Dr, St. Louis, 63110



Begin on the north western corner of the park and enter the Gaddy Garden trail that is adjacent to the savannah habitat. This trail is a top birding spot in St. Louis City and considered an important bird area.

**Trail Level: EASY (mulch/grass, flat)**

## Lafayette Park

2101 Park Ave, St. Louis, MO 63104



Begin by parking on this state's street and enter this 30-acre city park, circa 1851. This bow is on the western half of the park and find an area with lots of shrubs and young trees with a hidden brick path.

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, stairs, small incline)**

## World Bird Sanctuary

125 Bald Eagle Ridge Rd, Valley Park, 63088



Walk this enchanting path surrounded by birds from around the world. Look for the new LARGE structure & find your mystery bird nearby. \*Entry fee \$12 per car\*

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, small incline)**

## St. Vincent Greenway

7335 St. Charles Rock Rd, St. Louis, 63133

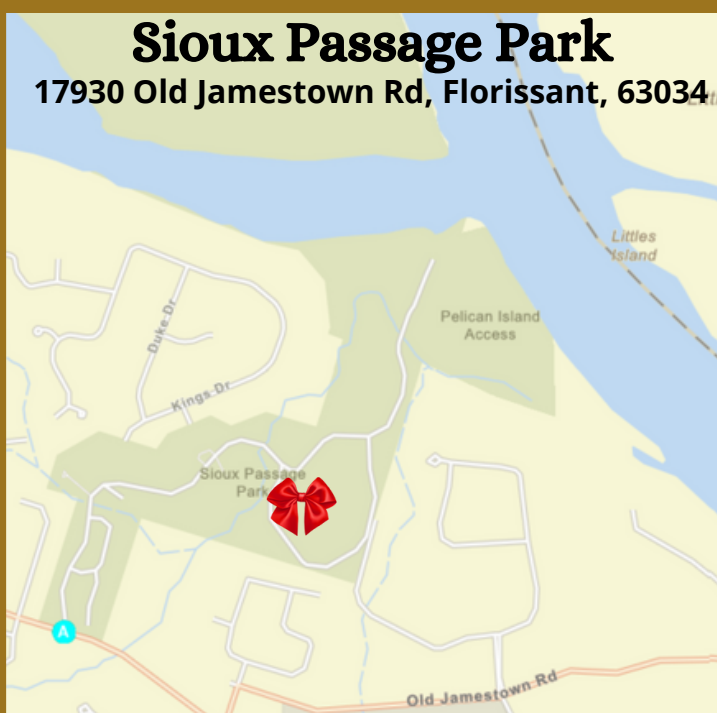


Park at the end of an eastern road ending in a carpark by the boardwalk. Begin your hike heading to the right and be on the lookout for birds that may hang out by small bridges!

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, flat)**

## Sioux Passage Park

17930 Old Jamestown Rd, Florissant, 63034

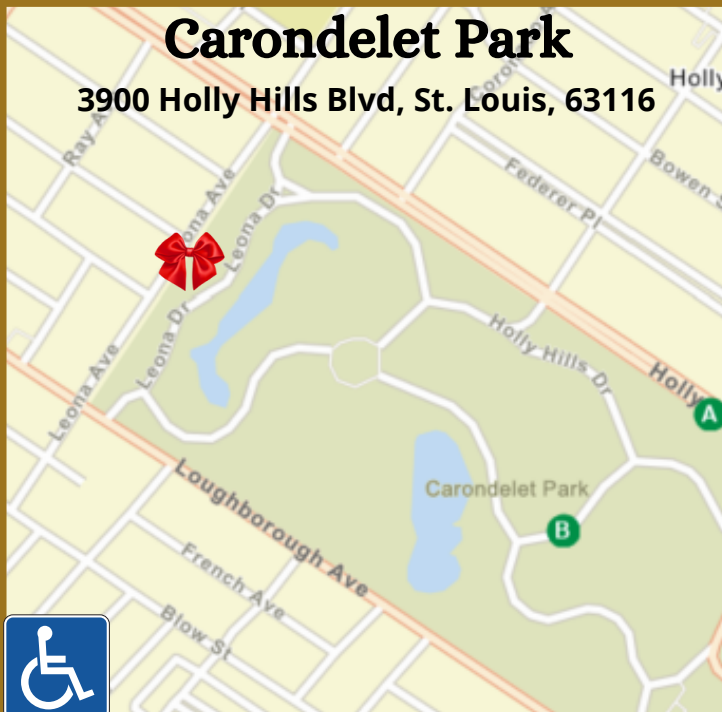


Follow the road into the park until you make it to a one-way loop drive. Get out and explore the woods around the disc golf course by the gravel parking lot and explore the creek.

**Trail Level: EASY (grassy, gravel, flat)**

## Carondelet Park

3900 Holly Hills Blvd, St. Louis, 63116



Walk along the large 1.5 mile loop trail and see the area in the park by horseshoe lake. Walk alongside Leona Dr and explore the nearby nature.

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, moderate incline)**

## Bellefontaine Conservation Area

Country Ln, St. Louis, MO 63136



Enter the area and find your way to Bluegill Lake on the north end of the park. Hike the loop trail down towards the water and keep a lookout for shiny things.

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, moderate incline)**

## Powder Valley Conservation Nature Center

11715 Cragwold Rd, Kirkwood, 63122



Head onto Tanglevine Trail and enjoy the storybook along the trail and keep your eyes out for a golden bow on a Black Cherry tree!

**Trail Level: EASY (paved, flat)**

## Laumeier Sculpture Park

12580 Rott Rd, St. Louis, 63127



Enter the park and start at the top of the lawns. Peer at the artwork and explore a wide field where you might spot a familiar woodland creature! Oh Deer!

**Trail Level: EASY (grass, minimal incline)**
