Great Backyard Bird Count Training & Kickoff

Over these four days we invite people to spend time in their favorite places watching and counting as many birds as they can find and reporting them to us. These observations help scientists better understand global bird populations before one of their annual migrations.

We hold a virtual *Great Backyard Bird Count* training via Facebook Live to help launch this massive community science effort each year.



The St. Louis region is located on the Mississippi Flyway, one of our planet's great migratory bird corridors. Over 300 bird species have been documented at the Riverlands Migratory Bird Sanctuary, home to the Audubon Center at Riverlands.
